Dear Colleagues,

Request for Mutual Assistance for ANPAC – Italy ALPA.

ANPAC Italy – the Airline Pilots' Association of Italy, are requesting Mutual Assistance for their *Alitalia* and *Alitalia Cityliner* members.

Since the beginning of 2016 ANPAC has been negotiating with the Alitalia management to resolve topics concerning their Collective Labour Agreement and other existing agreements, without success.

The main issues being disputed are the economic differences in contracts and the lack of career progression between *Alitalia* and *Alitalia Cityliner*, unrestricted wet leasing of aircraft, excessive crew workload, and pressure to extend Flight and Duty time limits, amongst others.

Industrial action, in the form of a strike, will start on September 22nd at 00:00 and finish on September 22nd at 23:59 LT.

ANPAC Italy hereby requests, through IFALPA, for Mutual Assistance as follows:

Ban on Wet Leasing (Para. 2.4.1.1)

Freeze in Capacity (for carriers **inside** the Alliance) (Para. 2.4.1.3)

Freeze in Capacity (for carriers **outside** the Alliance) (Para. 2.4.1.3)

Assistance to Pilots Stranded Away from Home Base (Para. 2.4.4)

Denial of Cockpit Crew Contracting (Para 2.4.5)

ANPAC Italy will keep IFALPA and its Member Associations informed of any further developments concerning this dispute.
